Co-Visits	Interdisciplinary Training	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IFSP service • Developmental Specialist (DS) • Reimbursable if child is enrolled in the Medicaid Children’s DD Waiver (ICF/ID level of care) • If the child only meets DD eligibility, or is not Medicaid, do not use interdisciplinary training. Continue to split the billable time between the DS and therapist 	“Early Intervention” services section NOTE: Only list it as interdisciplinary training if the DS is involved and the child meets ICF/ID level of care
Other Services ITP is not a provider of “other” services; however, ITP acts as Medicaid case managers. List these services on the child’s IFSP under “Other Services” and include them on the DD costing sheet. Medicaid Benefit Packages:

(ITP only provides Family Education and Interdisciplinary Training for Medicaid reimbursement)

A child who has Medicaid and meets DD eligibility qualifies for:

- State Plan Home and Community Based Services (HCBS)
 - Respite, Family Education, and Habilitative Supports
 - Children’s DD Case Management (Administrative activity)
- \$4,900 annual budget

A child who has Medicaid, meets DD eligibility and meets ICF/ID Level of Care qualifies for:

- Waiver Home and Community Based Services (HCBS)
 - Respite, Family Education, Habilitative Supports, Habilitative Intervention, Family Training, Interdisciplinary Training, Therapeutic Consultation, and Crisis.
 - Children’s DD Case Management (Administrative activity)
- \$6,200, \$8,400, and \$14,900 annual budget –
 - Therapeutic Consultation and Crisis are **NOT** counted towards the budget

A child who has Medicaid or CHIP, and has a need for therapy services qualifies for:

- State Plan Therapy Services
 - Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Speech-Language Pathology, and Audiology
- No Budget
