

Ninety (90) Day Progress Report

A progress report of individual services by the professional providing service(s) identified in the child's Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) is required every ninety (90) days.

The ninety (90) day progress report must document the child's review, assessments, and/or re-evaluations and any adjustments made to the IFSP by the IFSP team. In addition, documented review of progress towards goals and objectives must be included in the ninety (90) day review.

The ninety day review is considered part of the oversight requirements of providing service(s) to a child and is not billable separately.

Ninety day reviews must be documented in the data system and maintained in the child's permanent record.
