Wouldn't it be great if someone else helped keep track of you or your child's immunizations?

- What is IRIS? Idaho's Immunization Reminder Information System.
- A statewide system to help you and your healthcare provider keep track of your family's immunization records.
- Completely confidential and secure, your information can only be accessed by enrolled healthcare providers, schools, or child care programs.
- Enrollment in IRIS is completely voluntary.

Who can be enrolled in IRIS?

- Everyone with an immunization record.

How do you or your child get into IRIS?

- You need to sign a consent form to have you or your child's immunization information entered into the system.
- Consent forms are available through your healthcare provider, school or child care program.

How will IRIS help me?

- If you move or change providers... any enrolled site can retrieve your or your child's records.
- If your or your child's immunization record is lost... any enrolled site can retrieve and print an official copy of your or your child's immunization history.
- Schools and child care programs can retrieve and print an official copy of your child's immunization history.
- IRIS reduces the chance of having incorrect or additional immunizations given due to incomplete records.
- Immunization schedules are complex; IRIS helps your healthcare provider keep track of which of your child's immunizations are due and when.

What information is entered into IRIS?

This information is needed to identify you or your child in IRIS:

- Full name
- Birthdate
- Gender
- Mother's maiden name
- Guardian's first name (when applicable)

- Address
- Phone Number
- Information which may determine if your child is eligible for free vaccine.
- Your child's current shot record and any previous shots that have been given.
- Vaccine deferrals and exemptions.

Who has access to my or my child's immunization record through IRIS:

- You (through an enrolled site)
- Enrolled healthcare providers
- Enrolled schools and child care programs

I understand I may be asked for information that will help ensure my or my child's records are accurate and will not be confused with another person's records, such as: mother's maiden name, gender, and child's eligibility for free vaccine.
