VFC Vaccine Shipping and Ordering Changes

In an effort to improve vaccine management processes at the federal and state levels, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has implemented the following changes for vaccine shipping and ordering. These changes will begin effective April 30, 2007.

What providers need to know

- We hope that this will be a seamless transition for VFC providers. The major difference is the new vaccine distributor: McKesson [sample packing list attached].
- Providers will continue to submit VFC vaccine orders to the Hawaii VFC Program.
- There will be a "transition period" from 4/23/07 through 4/27/07. During this time, the Hawaii VFC Program will not process any vaccine shipments due to computer software and distributor transition. **For this reason, we encourage providers to place vaccine orders immediately to avoid delays or vaccine outages.**




