Advanced and Paramedic candidates must pre-register for an exam to ensure testing.

Exams are usually scheduled by the Bureau 60-90 days in advance of the exam and will appear on this report as soon as they are approved. The Bureau reserves the right to cancel any examination. Please be advised that some states may require specific educational criteria that Idaho does not. Please check with the State EMS licensing authority in the state in which you plan to seek licensure to ensure that your educational program meets their requirements.
