

Brian W. Gross, MD, FACC

Dr. Gross earned his medical degree from the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry and completed his internship and residency at Dartmouth Medical Center. He performed his cardiology fellowship at the University of Washington, where he also served as assistant professor of Medicine. He has been in private practice with Southern Oregon Cardiology in Medford since 1982. Dr. Gross is affiliated with Rogue Valley Medical Center and Providence Medford Medical Center, and has served as medical director of ASSET (Acute ST Segment Elevation TaskForce), a regional integrated, rapid response team for the recognition, transport, and treatment of major myocardial infarctions, since 2002. He has co-authored several articles on STEMI, including "An Approach to Shorten Time to Infarct Artery Patency in Patients with ST Segment Elevation Myocardial Infarction" in the *American Journal of Cardiology*, 2006.



Ivan Rokos MD, FACEP, FAHA, (FACC)


Dr. Rokos earned his medical degree from the Harvard-MIT Health Sciences and Technology program, and completed his internship at the New England Deaconess Hospital and residency at the Los Angeles County/USC Emergency Medicine Program. He gains his current clinical perspective from working in the academics of UCLA, the county hospital environment at Olive View-UCLA, and the busy community Emergency Departments at Northridge Hospital and Arcadia Methodist Hospital.

Dr. Rokos has served as a principal site investigator at Northridge and Olive View-UCLA on multiple clinical trials involving STEMI and NSTEMI patients; these multi-center trials were coordinated by the Boston TIMI group, DCRI at Duke, and CRF in New York. He has been very involved with planning regional STEMI care in LA County, and co-authored a paper explaining the rationale behind these efforts in the October 2006 issue of the *American Heart Journal*. He is a member of the American Heart Association Mission: Lifeline ECC committee and the ACTION-GWTG registry steering committee, and is chair of the AHA Western States Affiliate STEMI Task Force.
