The **Pediatric Asthma Learning Collaborative** is primarily intended to provide an opportunity for pediatricians and family physicians to improve the quality of care and outcomes for children with asthma in their practices. Physicians who are interested may also earn Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Part 4 credit from the American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) or the American Board of Family Medicine (ABFM). ***Please register early because space is limited and only practices that have pre-registered may attend.***

1. Please commit to the following before signing up to participate for MOC credit:

- Understand that the Learning Collaborative is not a onetime event but takes place over a period of 9 months and will require active participation of your team
- Agree to attend the September 30th learning session, a wrap-up session next June, at least one site visit to your practice, and have at least one practice staff present on each of the monthly technical assistance calls offered over the next 9 months. At a minimum the following staff must attend the September 30th learning session:
 - Physician/Mid-level champion for the practice
 - Each physician seeking MOC credit
 - Office manager
 - Nursing/Medical Assistant staff (at least one)
 - Any other staff the practice would like to attend
- Agree to conduct baseline and monthly chart audits (you will need to report on 10 patient asthma visits per month) and to develop a registry of children with asthma
- Meet regularly with your team (once every week or two is recommended) to work on improvement efforts
