Demonstration Participation

- In September, Medicaid received communication from the Duals office that the prospect of a Demonstration with only one participating health plan gave them discomfort for the following reasons:
 - Limits participant choice.
 - Creates a potential risk for continuation of the Demonstration if the plan opted out during the Demonstration period.
 - Passive enrollment in rural areas, but not in urban areas, where the majority of duals live and where more robust provider networks exist.

Duals As-Is Landscape

- **Idaho Medicaid has a Medicare-Medicaid Coordinated Plan (MMCP) for dual-eligible individuals with 600+ participants enrolled in one participating Medicare Advantage plan.**
- **This is a voluntary program that permits a dual-eligible beneficiary to enroll in a single managed care organization (MCO) that receives capitation payments to deliver both Medicaid and Medicare services to the individual.**

Duals To-Be Landscape

- **Per the Idaho Legislature direction in House Bill 260, Medicaid continues to work on the development of a managed care plan for dual eligibles that will result in an accountable system of care with improved health outcomes.**

Duals To-Be Landscape

- Medicaid remains interested in working with Health Plans to gather ideas on how to pursue integration of primary, acute, behavioral health and long term services and supports for full benefit Medicare-Medicaid enrollees. As the landscape with the Demonstration has changed, Medicaid is evaluating options to meet the Legislative direction.

Duals To-Be Landscape

- **Current options being considered are:**
 - Expand the covered benefits in the current MMCP in 2014.
 - Pursue the Demonstration starting in 2015.
 - Have multiple plans participate in MMCP in 2015.
