Transition Checklist	Amber	We may need to get a little bit more in depth with the transition checklist in order for the participants to know exactly what they are getting into, as well as, what to expect after transition.	Tammy and Don will look over the transition checklist from LINC and utilize what is deemed necessary for this project.
Possibility of Early Transition	Group	How can we get the participant into her own home without having a lapse in necessary services?	The participant will not have a lapse in services. If she has a current UAI (less than 1 year old) then the services will be provided based on the current UAI. If the participant does not have a current UAI, there is a crosswalk tool that can be utilized to take information from the MDS (from the institution) and plug it into the UAI. No matter what option is needed, the participant will receive a UAI 30 days after transition to reassess the participant's needs.
Meals-on-Wheels	Dana	Can a participant receive meals-on-wheels services without qualifying and being on the waiver?	The only way an individual would be able to qualify for meals-on-wheels is if they were over 60 and received this benefit through the Older American's Act.
Language Packet	Dana	Can we include a list of questions for the participant to ask so the participant can open all possible doors for the transition?	Tammy will include a sheet within the transition packet with items pertaining to questions that need to be asked in case of a roadblock.
Transitioning participants out of ICF/ID	Dana	Is there a different path for DD waiver participants than A&D waiver participants?	The difference in paths is the length of time it takes to get the participant qualified for the waiver and out of the institution. The DD waiver process could take up to 120 days where as the A&D waiver is a relatively quick turnaround.
