Round Table	Workgroup members	<p>Tammy reported of the \$22.7 million requested of the federal grant money, Idaho will receive \$6,548,984, due to a billion dollar national MFP shortage. With unobligated funds and the state match, IHC will have \$10.1 million to see us to the end of 2020. We will lower benchmarks and cap transitions annually to stay within our new budget.</p> <p>Chris Johnson asked if Hospice participation is still covered under IHC MFP and she gave Cathy a contact for follow-up.</p> <p>The grant will accept the last participants on 12/31/18, carry them through 365 days, and on 1/1/19 Transition Management and Transition Services will seamlessly be added to the DD and A&D Waiver programs. Enhanced coverage will no longer be eligible for IHC.</p>	Tammy will continue to send quarterly reports and welcomes any calls or emails with questions that may come up.
