





Lincoln County is located in south-central Idaho. It ranks 37th among Idaho counties in population and 25th in area. The federal government owns about 76 percent of the county. Agriculture is the major industry, with government providing nearly half the non-farm wage and salary jobs in the county. Annual average total civilian employment increased 21.4 percent from 1996 to 2006. Major employers include Glanbia Inc., the U.S. Bureau of Land Management, Shoshone, Richfield and Dietrich school districts, Lincoln County government, and Big Wood Canal Company.

The Shoshone Ice Cave in the northwest part of the county is considered one of the natural wonders of the world. The ice-floored lava cave is over 1,000 feet long.




Level and Type of EMS Courses 2005-2007






Poison Control Calls for CY2006





Highway Miles (Gravel is considered improved)







EMS Agency Licensure Levels




EMS Agency Structure




EMS Agency Classification




EMS Agency Structure Transport/NonTransport



EMS Agency Staff Mix 2007-2008



Historic EMS Manpower Complement 2000-2008












All Transport and Non Transport Agency Patient Care Report Submissions




Dedicated Fund Vehicle Grants
