
Dear Ms. Eidle:

I am writing a letter in support of Medicaid reviewing Toviaz for their formulary. There are several anticholinergic agents on the market. In general, they are usually equally effective, however, if one agent stands out as being more effective it would be Toviaz. Even more importantly, it tends to cause fewer side effects than the other agents. Many of our Medicaid patients are older or have mental handicaps. Some of the other anticholinergic agents, especially Oxybutynin, can cause significant confusion.

I hope you will carefully consider the advantages that Toviaz provides when you consider the formulary issue.
