SUBJECT: ATR 4 Funding Availability

The implementation of ATR 4 will be a phased in according to the schedule as follows:

- Tuesday, January 6, 2015
 - Veterans with a Substance Use Disorder (SUD) who have committed a crime and are on supervised probation
 - Child Welfare families, specifically parents with a SUD and involvement in Child Welfare Court
- Tuesday, January 20, 2015
 - Individuals experiencing homelessness, both sheltered and unsheltered

Referrals will only be accepted from the following sources:

- Supervised Veterans – Veteran Court Coordinator or a Misdemeanant Probation Officer refer clients using the Funding Profile Form located at www.bpahealth.com.
- Child Welfare – CPS Liaisons or a Child Protection Drug Court Coordinator refer clients using the Funding Profile Form located at www.bpahealth.com.
- Homeless – Community-based service provider assists clients in calling BPA for phone screening at (800) 922-3406.
