SUBJECT: Changes to PWWC Eligibility

The Division of Behavioral Health (DBH) has expanded the eligibility requirements for the PWWC client population. Formerly only women that were pregnant or up to 12 months post-partum were able to access PWWC funding due to past budget restrictions. As of October 23, 2014, the eligibility has been expanded to include:

- Pregnant women;
- Women with dependent children ages 3 or younger.

DBH will continue to monitor the intake rate and expenditures for this population and implement further expansion if necessary. If you have any questions about PWWC funding or the eligibility requirements please contact your BPA Regional Coordinator.
