**Recovery Coach Training**

Participants: 30  
New trainers: 15

Participants will take their skills back to their regions and provide ongoing training.

**Trauma Informed Care Web Portal**

Recovery and trauma focused.

Participants will develop a web-based platform with resources and tools that can be utilized by anyone.

**Action Plan Toolkit Development**

Identification of gaps and needs.

Action plan development and implementation.

Track data and report outcomes.

**Promotes a statewide recovery system in 3 ways**



RITE-TTI peer specialists model recovery as they facilitate project implementation, track data and report on RITE-TTI project outcomes.

Participants are recruited from Idaho's seven regions and two state hospitals. After the project, they will share information with their regions.

Participants include behavioral health stakeholders from mental health and substance use, with a focus on behavioral health integration and recovery.
