

Previously an Associate Professor of Pharmacology and Anesthesiology at the Oregon Health Sciences University, Dr. Julien lectures widely on pharmacology. Dr. Julien firmly believes that non-prescribing mental health professionals need to understand the medications that their clients are taking or may need to take.

With over 30 years of continuous publication, Dr. Julien's psycho-pharmacology textbook, *A Primer of Drug Action* (Worth Publishers), is regarded as the definitive textbook of psychopharmacology, covering both psychotherapeutic agents as well as substances of abuse.
