WHAT: The Idaho Suicide Prevention Hotline is recruiting volunteers to staff the call room. As you may know, Idaho is the only state without a hotline, and has been since 2006.

WHY? Idaho also has one of the highest suicide rates in the country. We are looking to fill this void and offer a valuable resource to the state.

WHO: We are seeking volunteers who are caring, compassionate, open-minded, empathetic, reflective, good listeners, and possess a strong work ethic.

TRAINING: Volunteers will receive Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST), training on special topics, and training on general hotline procedures. We are asking for a 4 hour per week commitment for 1 year.
