Presenter: Chandra Ippen Ghosh, PhD is Associate Research Director of the Child Trauma Research Program at the University of California, San Francisco and a member of the National Child Traumatic Stress Network. She is a clinician, researcher, and trainer. She is co-author of a randomized trial documenting the efficacy of child-parent psychotherapy (CPP), co-author of *Guidelines for the Treatment of Traumatic Bereavement in Infancy and Early Childhood* (2003), which describes CPP treatment for Childhood Traumatic Grief, author of four chapters related to diversity-informed practice, and has over 7 years of experience conducting trainings in CPP and diversity-informed practice.
