

**Subject:** Commercial Bus Pass Reimbursement

Starting November 1, 2012, the purchase of commercial bus passes for Developmental Disability and Aged and Disabled Waiver participants by non-medical waiver transportation providers will be authorized using service code A0110.

**Note:** The purchase of bus passes for *medical transportation* is arranged through the Department's transportation contractor and is not subject to billing through service code A0110.

Non-medical transportation is a service that enables a waiver participant to gain access to waiver and other community services and resources. As part of non-medical transportation, service code A0110 can be used to purchase commercial bus passes for a waiver participant. Bus passes are manually priced for the cost of the pass and prior authorized for the public transportation provider, if they have a valid contract with the Department.

Claims submitted before November 1, 2012, using service code A0080 that were paid incorrectly, will be handled on a case-by-case basis. To have a claim corrected, providers should contact their regional Medicaid office (please see table below) so that the prior authorization related to non-medical transportation can be adjusted. Once the prior authorization has been corrected, the provider will need to reverse the original claim and submit a new claim. When submitting the new claim, providers should use the original prior authorization number in order to receive a timely adjustment.
