

CURRENT PROVIDERS

The National Center for Disease Control and Prevention funds State Health Departments for HIV and STD Prevention efforts through a competitive process. Once the funds are dedicated to Idaho they are provided to providers. Most [health districts](#) throughout Idaho receive funding for prevention efforts and testing. Additionally, community-based organizations can receive funding based upon their plan. As with any limited resource, the funds are distributed to providers based upon a committee decision, once a proposal has been called for and submitted.

Once a provider has been approved for funding and a contract signed, they are responsible for submitting information required by the State Office and CDC. Additionally, program evaluation efforts are required. Participation in evaluative activities provides data on which to base future activities. This is necessary so we can continuously provide the most effective programs possible.
