# Glossary

Field	Definition / Method
Category (heading)	This report is divided into categories, with a separate page for each category. The categories are:  - Adolescents  - Adults  - CPS (Clients with child protection cases open at time of screening)  - Dual Diagnosis (Clients who reported having been diagnosed with a mental illness at time of screening)  - Court Supervised (Clients on probation or under some other court supervision, including CPS and drug court)  - Drug Court (Clients referred by a drug court or having services paid by drug court funds)  - PWWC (Pregnant Women and Women with Children)
Client Count (general)	The following fields are client counts. A client count is the number of unique clients who had at least one paid claim during the period covered by the report.
Total Clients	Total client count. Not one region: if a client moves to a different region during the time period covered by the report, the client will be counted in each region in which he lived while receiving services. However, that client will still be counted only once in the statewide count.
Gender	Client count for each gender
Age	Client count for each age range. Note: a client may change age groups during the time period covered by the report. In such a case, the client will be counted in each age group in which he fell while receiving services.
Race / Ethnicity	Client count for each race or ethnicity and for Hispanic ethnicity
Primary Substance	Client count indicating the given substance as their Primary Substance during screening.
Pregnant when screened (PWWC only)	Client count of those answering 'yes' when asked 'Are you currently pregnant' during screening.
Median wait days	For all episodes in which the client received the first paid service during the time period covered by the report, this is the Median of the number of days from screening to that first paid service for all clients in the given category and region.
Median length of stay	For all episodes which ended during the time period covered by the report, this is the Median of the number of days from the first paid service to the final paid service in the episode.
GPRA Indicators:	The following fields are amalgams of responses to GPRA questions, averaged for Intake and Discharge GPRA interviews. Discharge interviews are those that occurred during the given time period. Intake interviews are those that match the reported Discharge interviews.
Used alcohol or drugs in past 30 days	In Section B of GPRA Interview, client answered with some non-zero number of days to use of any of the listed substances in the past 30 days
Living Indpendently or with family/friends past 30 days	Client answered 'Independent Living' to question C1: 'In the past 30 days, where have you been living most of the time?' Independent living is defined as 'Living on his/her own, self-supported, with family or friends, or in non-supervised group homes'.
Currently employed or in school	Client answered 'Enrolled, full time' or 'Enrolled, part time' to question D1: 'Are you currently enrolled in a school or a job training program?' AND/OR answered 'Employed full time' or 'Employed part time' to question D1: 'Are you currently employed?'
Arrested during past 30 days	Client gave a non-zero response to question E1: 'In the past 30 days, how many times have you been arrested?' AND/OR a non-zero response to question E3: 'In the past 30 days, how many nights have you spent in jail/prison?'
Social connectedness past 30 days	Client answered 'Yes' to one or more of questions F1, F2, F3, and F4, which whether the client attended various types of self-help or other recovery support groups and/or had interaction with family and/or friends who are supportive of the client's recovery
