Teacher Procedure:								

	<p>The instructor will go over signs and symptoms of a pelvic fracture. They will also demonstrate how to apply the pelvic immobilizer splint. After this is done they will have the class do the psychomotor skills of applying the splint.</p> <p>They will then give them a written exam on the pelvic injuries and also on the devices they can use to immobilize the pelvis.</p> <p>They will then have the students do a psychomotor skills test on this device.</p>
